# ABOUT LAUREL HOUSE APARTMENTS

## 34 HOMES FOR YOUTH WHO NEED THEM MOST.

The Laurel House Apartments will have 34 one-bedroom apartments that will provide permanent, safe housing to the youth in the Grand Valley who are most at risk of long-term homelessness.

The program provides youth with access to mental health services and assists youth in finding jobs at local businesses. We also provide help with school enrollment, substance abuse mitigation, and life-skills training.



## LONG-TERM COMMUNITY IMPACT

We expect this project to benefit Mesa County by saving the community millions of dollars. According to a study commissioned by Philip Mangano, George W. Bush' homeless policy expert, the cost of sustaining individuals in homelessness is between \$35,000 to \$150,000 per year. Costs include homeless shelters, emergency rooms, social services, and costs incurred from exposure to severe weather, sexual assault or human trafficking. Therefore, we expect this project to save the community between \$13.2 and \$56.4 million dollars over its 40-year lifetime, and between \$1.4 and 6 million just in the first year.

**1 OUT OF 4** homeless individuals in Mesa County are under the age of 18. The mission of all Karis programs is to bridge youth **HOME**.

## SOP

The Street Outreach Program (SOP) reaches out to homeless, runaway and unaccompanied youth between ages 13 and 24 in Mesa County who are living on the street or couch surfing.

## ZOE HOUSE PROGRAM

Zoe House is a safe transitional housing program for youth survivors of domestic violence, dating violence, sexual assault and stalking. Zoe House serves youth ages 18-24 and their dependents.

## BONNIE'S HOUSE

Bonnie's House offers 5 beds of long-term housing for individuals that are ages 18 and older.

## THE HOUSE PROGRAM

The House is a 10 bed temporary shelter for homeless, runaway, and unaccompanied youth ages 13 through 20.

## TLP PROGRAM

Matthew's House, Benni's House, and three licensed Host Homes make up our Transitional Living Program. The TLP provides 11 beds and services for up to two years.

## LAUREL HOUSE APARTMENTS

34 units of permanent supportive housing for youth most at risk of experiencing long-term homelessness. Scheduled to open in October 2020.

## SERVICES THAT INVITE YOUTH HOME

All Karis programs provide youth with access to mental health services, and assist youth in finding jobs at local businesses such as Graff Dairy. We also provide help with school enrollment, substance abuse mitigation, and provide life skills training.

## 24/7 ON CALL SERVICES

Karis and The House provide 24/7 On Call Services to homeless youth in need. If you have questions or concerns about a homeless youth in need please call 970-234-7004, 24 hours per day/7 days per week.
